



The Crowe Morgan English Skeet Grand Prix was held at Meary Veg Santon on Saturday 18th and Sunday 19th June 2011.

15 shooters took part in the Saturday event that was split into three squads

The leaders after the first round were John Moore and Jeff Corkill with perfect 25 straights next came Stan Cross and Glen Catlin on 24 followed by two shooters on 23

The second round got under way and Moore once again hit a perfect score of 25 to take the lead by two from Cross and Corkill on 48 with Catlin and Dave Corlett on 47 next. In the third and last round of the day all eyes were on Moore wanting to see if he could do 75 straight but the answer was no as he couldn't get past the first stand, he missed two low house targets plus one other in the round to finish on 22 for a final total of 72. Cross and Corkill who were next up who all could beat Moore by hitting straights but Cross missed two targets to finish one behind Moore but Corkill only missed one to tie with Moore to force a shoot off for the High gun prize, Catlin could tie with Corkill and Moore if he hit a straight but he missed one to tie with Cross in equal third spot. In the shoot off for High gun between Corkill and Moore, Corkill came out the victor by two targets.

On the Sunday 18 shooters took part who were split into four squads

The leader after the first round were Glen Catlin and Stan Cross on 24 even after Catlin missed his first target out, next came Nick Dutnall, Peter Kelly, Victor Annand and Rachael Bowen Matthews on 23 with Dave Corlett next on 22. In the second round Catlin once again hit 24 to take the lead on 48 with Cross next on 47 followed by Annand on 46 then Kelly, Dutnall and John Moore on 45. In the third and last round Catlin once again hit 24 to finish on 72 which was good enough for the high gun prize. Next came Cross on 70 hitting 23 in his last round, he was followed by Moore on 69 who had 24 in his last round as well as Annand on 69

The overall High gun cup is decided by the top five shooters combined scores from Saturday and Sunday's going forward to a grand final and they were Catlin 143, Moore and Cross 141, Corkill 137 and Dutnall 136, and at the end Catlin came out a deserved winner by hitting all 25 targets for a grand

total of 168 next came Moore on 166 he to hit all 25 in the final, with Cross next on 164, then Dutnall 160 then Corkill 158.

The prizes at the end were presented by Dave Morgan on behalf of Crowe Morgan the sponsors
